

Birds of Whitewebbs Park 2020

A total of 78 species of bird have been seen so far during 2020. **Some of the highlights of the year have been Sand Martin, House Martin, Raven, Common Tern, Pied Flycatcher and Short-eared Owl. These are all birds that have not been seen in Whitewebbs Park in any previous years.**
